## **Tournament Rules**

- 1. This is a singles event bowling tournament.
- 2. Registration is handled online through the QR code on the front of the flyer. If you have questions, please contact the tournament director listed below.
- 3. The handicap is 90% of 220. If you do not have a handicap established in a league you will bowl scratch (no handicap).
  - a. Your handicap is based on your highest average from any league in the past two years.
  - b. Each bowler is responsible for fairly reporting their average. If their average is in question the tournament director will ask for verification (USBC reporting, weekly standing sheet, etc.)
- 4. Multiple entries into the tournament are allowed.
- 5. Substitutes are not allowed.
- 6. Bowlers must wear bowling shoes to bowl.
- 7. All equipment and use must follow the USBC regulations.
- 8. Lane assignments will be at random. You can request to bowl with friends and family, after all, we want you to have a great time!
- 9. The payout is one cash prize for every five entries.
- 10. Results will be announced at the end of the tournament.
- 11. Bowlers must check-in 15 minutes before the start of the tournament or your spot may be given out.
- 12. Artesia Lanes may move bowlers if needed for mechanical issues and to keep the tournament running.
- 13. Entry fees due at check-in. Cash payments only.
- 14. All proceeds, minus payout, go to the Artesia Lanes Allstars Youth Bowling League for shirts, prizes, and Pepsi College funds.
- 15. All Artesia Lanes All Stars Youth Bowling League staff are volunteers.
- 16. The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler before the start of a squad.
- 17. Youth are not permitted to make bets or gamble.
- 18. Youth may bowl in SINGLES competition (including side pots/brackets) offering such prizes as mentioned above provided prior to bowling:
  - a. The youth sign the Consent Form and the competition agrees to award the youth's prize in the form of a scholarship; or
  - b. The youth sign the Consent Form waiving his/her rights to any prizes which may be in violation of this rule.
